Often called the “silent thief of sight,” it accounts for 9 – 12% of all cases of blindness in the US.*



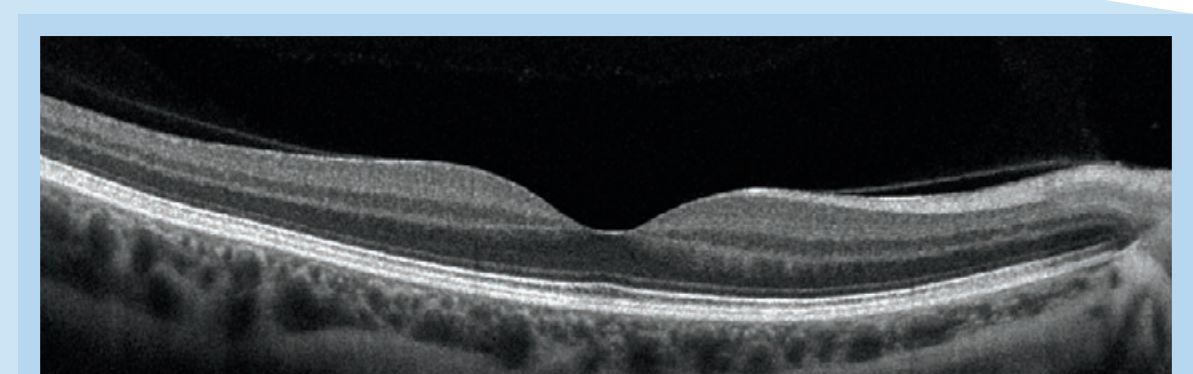
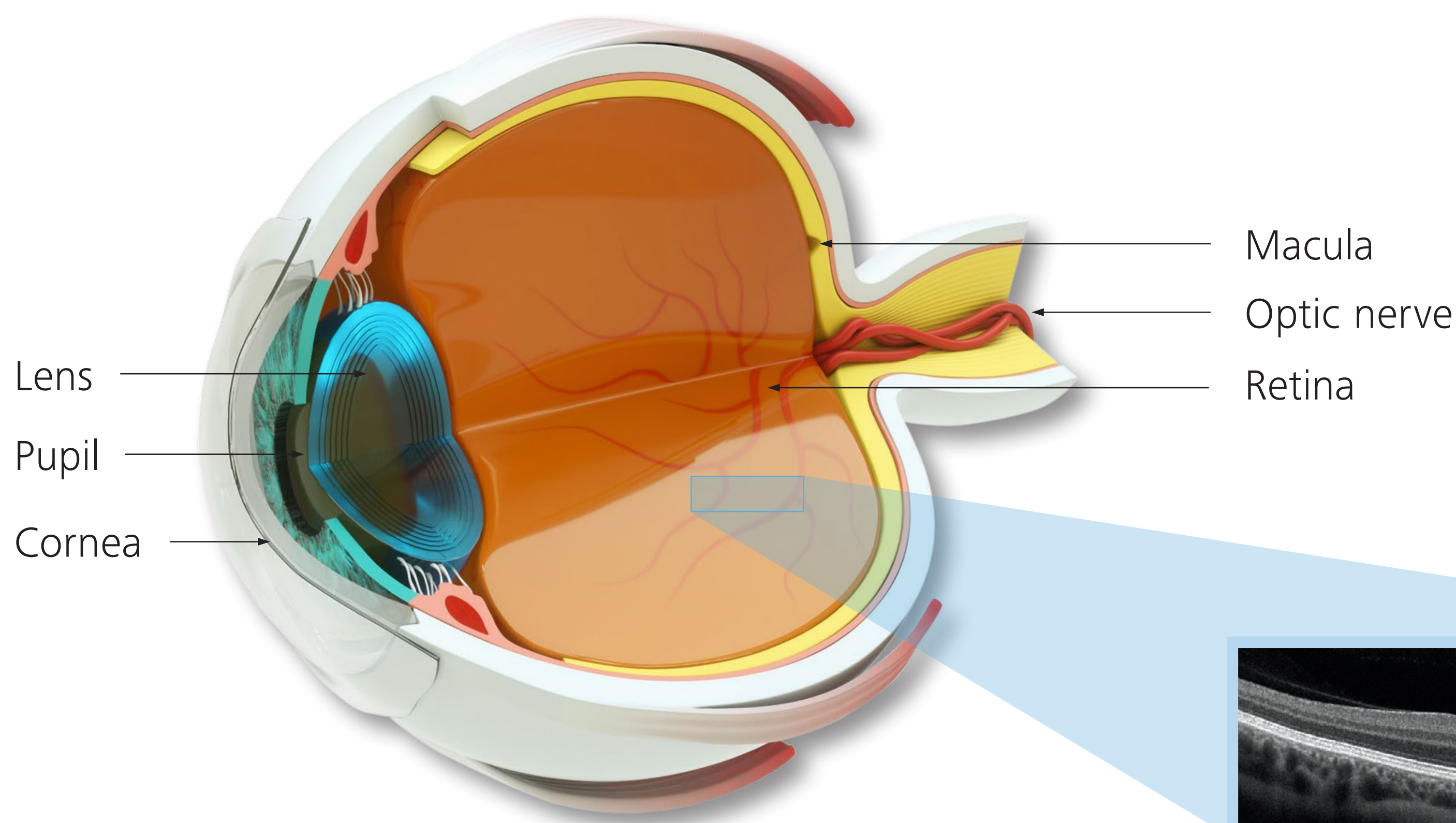
Diabetic retinopathy

It is estimated that one-third of adults with diabetes over the age of 40 are affected by diabetic retinopathy.



Macular degeneration

A rapidly progressing eye disease that often goes undetected, it is the leading cause of central vision loss in people over 60.



OCT Exam: Images the back of your eye to assess the health of your retina.

Glaucoma, macular degeneration, and diabetic retinopathy are very difficult to detect. Early symptoms are not easily identified with conventional eye examination methods. A retinal scan with advanced technology known as optical coherence tomography is a fast and non-invasive way to assess the health of your eyes. **Consult your eye doctor for more information.**
